Dear Parent/Carers,

Further to feedback that we have received from parents, pupils and staff I have spoken with my senior leadership team/ teaching staff and can confirm that we have made amendments to the schedule of events sent out last week.

Please see below:

Harvest Service – All children will participate in a Harvest celebration that will include a performance by each class of a set song, poem or story (no external audience).

Remembrance Service – All children will have the opportunity to pay their respects by participating in a one-minute silence. The service of remembrance will be led by our Year 5 and 6 pupils (Year 5 and 6 parents and carers invited).

Christmas Performance – The children from Nursery to Year 2 will put on a special Christmas show, performing songs and actions to entertain our audience (Parents and carers invited).

Christmas Carol Service – The children in Years' 3 to 6 will perform a range of traditional and modern Christmas songs and carols, including readings (Parents and carers invited).

Easter Assembly - All children will participate in an Easter celebration that will include short performances by each class/ phase of a set song, poem or story (no external audience).

Y6 Leavers Service– Year 6 pupils will have an opportunity to perform in a celebration concert aimed at highlighting their skills, talents and experiences including their memories and aspirations (Parents and carers invited).

There will be additional opportunities throughout the academic year for parents to visit school to see their child's work/ special performance by the class etc..

Please accept our apologies if the changes we suggested last week caused upset. Our motivation for change was to allow more opportunities for children to participate in events however we do value your feedback hence the reason for these changes.
